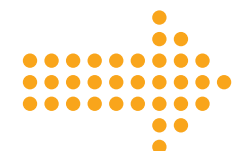
Let us do all the tedious tasks you may not get around to quite as often as you should, ensuring your visitors have a trouble free, pleasurable experience.

Adding news/blog items can have big benefits for your site, not only does it increase the number of pages on your site (Google loves more pages), but it also allows you to target particular markets, products and customer types. All you need to supply is the text, leave the rest to us!

Our Extra Plan adds an additional £15 per month.

What you need to know:

The plans are paid either as a monthly direct debit on a 12 month contract or we offer a 5% discount when paid yearly in advance and all prices are plus vat.

We always recommend updating plug-ins on a monthly basis and the Wordpress Core when required. Why? well, plug-ins and the core are usually updated by the developers for one of two reasons.

1. They are updated to improve how they work, there may be new additional features or may have a tweak to work better with a recent web browser update.
2. A security flaw has been discovered and an updated version has been released to patch the flaw.

Both of the above are big reasons to update, however occasionally a new plug-in update can cause a conflict with something else on your site, be it another plug-in or the theme itself this can create an error on your site. Although a fairly rare occurrence, if this was to happen as a result of our updates, we would need to charge for any remedial work, the good news is, if you have one of our plans, we reduce the price for diagnosing and correcting the issue by 25%.
